

Eligibility Requirements to Sit for the ASCCP Colposcopy Mentorship Program Examination

Persons/Mentees eligible to sit for the examination include:

- Mentees who have completed the first two tiers of the ASCCP Colposcopy Mentorship Program
 - * Documentation of an ACCME-accredited colposcopy course (minimum 14 hours Category 1 CME or CEU hours)
 - * Documentation of having registered for and completed an **ASCCP-approved** mentorship training program including 25 supervised, consecutive colposcopic examinations (to include 3 high-grade findings). *NOTE: Written notice of formal registration and mentor/mentee approval must be received from the ASCCP National Office prior to the start of the mentorship training. No colposcopy exams performed retroactively to the date of the written notification will be allowed.*
 - * Letter from ASCCP attesting to exam eligibility.

OR

- * Documentation of having received colposcopy training in a US-accredited (ACGME) residency program within the last 5 years. Acceptable residency documentation would be a letter from the program director attesting to training and supervision during 25 colposcopic examinations.
- * Letter from ASCCP attesting to exam eligibility.
