

## **Eligibility Requirements to Sit for the ASCCP Colposcopy Mentorship Program Examination**

Persons/Mentees eligible to sit for the examination include:

Mentees who have completed the first two tiers of the ASCCP Colposcopy Mentorship Program. The following documents must be on file at the ASCCP National office:

- ❖ Documentation of an ACCME-accredited colposcopy course (minimum 14 hours Category 1 CME or CEU hours)
- ❖ Documentation of having registered for and completed an **ASCCP-approved** mentorship program including 25 supervised colposcopic examinations (to include 3 cervical high-grade findings and other specifications outlined in the requirements form).  
*NOTE: Written notice of formal registration and mentor/mentee approval must be received from the ASCCP National Office prior to the start of the mentorship training. No colposcopy exams performed retroactively to the date of the written notification will be allowed.*
- ❖ Letter from ASCCP attesting to exam eligibility.

### **OR**

- ❖ Documentation of having received colposcopy training in a U.S.-accredited (ACGME) residency program within the last 5 years. Residency documentation must include a letter from the program attesting to the physician's colposcopy training and supervision of at least 25 colposcopic examinations to include three high grade findings.
- ❖ Letter from ASCCP attesting to exam eligibility.
