ASCCP-CSCCP Colposcopy Courses were successfully held in Beijing, Shanghai and Xi'an in China

2024 ASCCP-CSCCP Colposcopy Comprehensive Courses were successfully held from October 25 to 27 in Beijing, October 29 to 31 in Xi'an, and November 1 to 3 in Shanghai. This is the 6th colposcopy comprehensive course jointly held by the Chinese Society of Colposcopy and Cervical Pathology (CSCCP), and the American Society of Colposcopy and Cervical Pathology (ASCCP) since 2017. The faculty included two ASCCP experts, Dr. Michael Gold, previous ASCCP President, University of Oklahoma School of Community Medicine, and Dr. Chengquan Zhao, University of Pittsburgh Medical Center, as well as more than 300 CSCCP experts including Dr. Lihui Wei, president, and Dr. Long Sui, vice president of CSCCP. About fifty gynecologists participated in the training course at each site.



On the first day of the training course, colposcopies and treatments were demonstrated with real-time broadcasts by experts, who gave trainees intuitive and vivid understanding of colposcopy, LEEP, CKC and ablative treatment. Afterward, the trainees also practiced doing simulation exercises.



On the second day theoretical lectures were given by ASCCP and CSCCP experts. The lectures presented colposcopy topics including normal transformation zone, low grade and high grade dysplasias, cancer, and challenges related to screening and diagnosing endocervical glandular lesions. Advanced technology and innovations in diagnosis and treatment strategy of various types of cervical, vaginal and vulvar lesions were also presented.



On the third day, cases were presented by CSCCP experts and interpretated by Dr. Michael A. Gold and Dr. Chengquan Zhao. At each location interesting cases were selected for discussion. Comprehensive and in-depth analysis of the cases were conducted, with experts exchanging ideas face-to-face, allowing participants to gain a deeper understanding of the full spectrum of lower genital tract disease.

The two-and-a-half-day agenda combined examination, operative demonstrations, didactic lectures and distinctive pathology report discussions. Dr. Wei Lihui, president of CSCCP, greatly appreciated the contributions of ASCCP experts, as well as the active participation of the trainees, which ensured the successful completion of the 2024 CSCCP-ASCCOP Colposcopy Training Program. We anticipate that the trainees will find that this program helpful in their future medical practices. Finally, Dr. Wei expressed hope that CSCCP and ASCCP would continue to build a close relationship, moving forward to create a better future.
